The 3 Deadly Mistakes Most Beginners Don't Even Know They Make!

- 1:** **NOT learning to use your hands and fingers properly** - developing bad habits which stunts technique and can take years to fix.
- 2:** **NOT learning basic music theory** - because you think it's too hard, boring or tricky. But it's the biggest shortcut to learning guitar fast!
- 3:** **NOT practicing the basics on a regular basis** - the pro's practice the basics every day... you should too. Always practice chord progressions.

FACT: Over 90% of beginners NEVER master the basics!

That's because they don't truly understand what the basics really involve...

... You probably think the basics are just learning a few 'basic' chords, a scale or two and away you go - right? And because of this you have just rushed in and started learning those chords and some songs from tabs off the net and/or your mates, or, from some books. You need understand that **the basics are extremely important... especially** if you want to **set yourself up for learning fast** and for being able to play effortlessly with good technique.

There are 3 areas I'll talk about that **you need to be aware of** and **give the necessary daily attention** to when learning to play guitar...

1. **You will learn *how* to use your hands and fingers the correct way to **avoid excess tension** and **wasted movement**. This applies to the fretting and picking hands. Getting this wrong, (as most do), will **severely limit your technique and the speed at which you can play and learn**.**
2. **You will discover** the importance of basic music 'theory' of **what scales and chords are**. If **there is a shortcut**, then this is it! This basic knowledge can help you **learn to play songs 3, 5, 7 or even 15 times faster** than those without this knowledge! In other words, you will **make more efficient use of your practice time to gain a potent unfair advantage** over everyone else.
3. **You will also** begin to **understand how to practice, what to practice and when to practice...** rather than wasting valuable time flitting from one thing to another like most beginners. Rather than being like a directionless ship without a rudder **you will have direction and purpose** and **you will achieve your guitar playing dreams *very quickly***.
